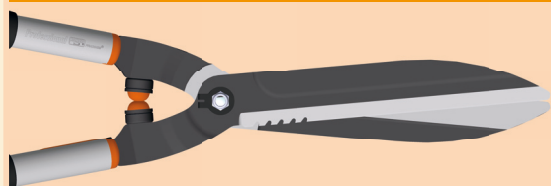


Hedge shears are made with three distinct blade designs: STRAIGHT, NARROW and WAVY BLADED SHEARS. Although any of these shears can cut most types of hedges, each design has features which make it especially good for a particular application.

### Straight Bladed Shears

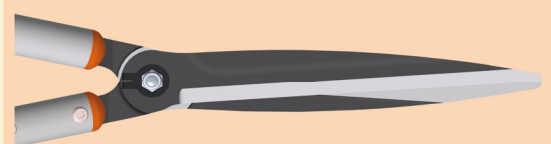


Long, very sharply ground blades, mainly used for hedge trimming on plants with thicker wigs. The professional models have a serrated edge near the bottom of the blade for gripping larger twigs and hard wood during cutting.

Main area of application:  
**Landscape**



### Narrow Bladed Shears



Narrow blades with smooth edges, mainly used for trimming leaves and soft shoots. Result into a very clean cut.

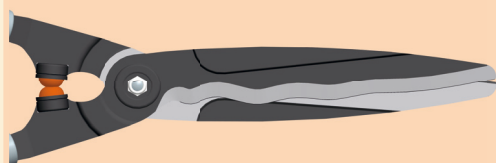
Main areas of application:  
**Landscape: topiary**



**Viticulture: leaf pruning**



### Wavy Bladed Shears



Two very sharp blades, ground to a distinctive wavy shape. The waves trap groups of twigs and prevent them sliding along the blade. This ensures a more even finish to the hedge. Especially useful for cutting hard wood hedges and plants with a fairly open structure.

### Edging and Lawn Shears

Precision blade-and-edge grass shears with extended handles and non-stick blades. The blades are angled to enable borders and lawns to be trimmed without stooping.

### Grass Shears

Self-grinding blades which swivel into three positions enabling to cut at various angles while holding the tool in a comfortable working position. Grass shears are suited for light work, especially pot and balcony gardening.

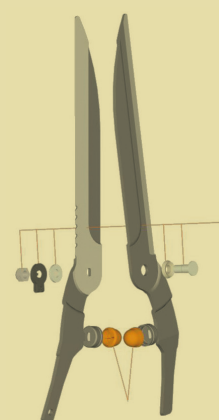

The compact design with angled forms of the **P54-SL** makes the tool perfect to use on topiary plants and trellis systems. The P54H-SL has been designed with 36 cm long handles for all types of leaf cutting and plant shaping where a long reach is required.

The **P57 range** feature tradition wooden handles. The blades are uncoated to allow for hand-sharpening.

Maintenance & Sharpening

A small amount of attention to your hedge shear at the end of a work session will keep it in top condition. Here's how:


1. Moisten a rag with SAP-X until it feels damp. Wipe sap and debris from the blade and counterblade

2. Cleaning the blade with an oily rag coats them with a layer that helps protect them against rust




Just a few moments spent sharpening your hedge shear will keep it ready for action.

Use a Tungsten-carbide sharpener to keep the blade razor sharp during the day.



Use a grained stone to take away notches and a fine grain to finish the cutting edge.




Hold the hedge shear as shown and stroke the blade 5 times in the direction of the arrows.

3a. Sharpen


Work on the honing angle with 5 strokes.









3b. Deburr

Remove burrs with one light stroke on the back side. Keep sharpener or stone almost flat or with a slight angle of 10°



4. Put a few drops of Bahco Eco-Lube100 onto the blade and let them soak towards the bolt.
